Lettuce butterhead

Lactuca sativa. Compact butterhead-type lettuce, Plant produces good yields of a light green butterhead type lettuce. It is a very popular variety because it grows higher off the ground, so the bottom leaves don't rot. Can tolerate the cold, easy to grow. Day to Maturity | 55 days



Lettuce Cos

Large, upright, full-bodied heads with dark-green, slightly savoyed leaves that are mild and sweet. Excellent performer in the inter-mountain region. Plant reaches about 10 inches tall. Midribs are crunchy and juicy. Because of their higher chlorophyll content, romaine lettuces are among the most nutritious of all lettuces. Mosaic tolerant, Day to Maturity | 50-80 days



Lettuce Iceberg

The variety with dark and vivid brilliant green leaves. It has large heavy heads and well closed base, resistance to bolting. The smooth leaf is slightly wavy and the root is fine. This is suitable for spring and autumn cultivation in open field or greenhouse or tunnel cultivation in the south. The head is very uniform. The plant is tolerant to *bremia* and tip burns as well as bacterial rot.



Lettuce No26 Lollo

Voluminous and heavy tuft with green finely indented leaves, suitable for green house and open field sowing. Beautiful round mound of pale green, crisp frilled edged leaves. Appreciated for its unique shape and refreshing taste, it holds well in summer and in the cold.



Lettuce No27

Lactuca sativa var. crisp, green, wrinkled leaves, good adaptability and disease resistance, delicious and excellent quality.



Lettuce No28

Grand Rapids lettuce. Half erect plant, light green, quality, sweet crisp, no fiber, not easy bolting, fast growth, maturity, about 45 days after sowing resistant insect resistance is strong, a wide adaptability, can be perennial plant 10 degrees in the temperature region can be harvested in about 45 days after planting, with good heat resistance and cold resistance.

Suitable for raw food, lettuce salad and cooking. Rich in beta, vitamin B1, C, calcium, iron and food fiber



Lettuce No29

loose leaf lettuces. Frilly light green leaves stay crisp and tender after cutting. Very crisp and free from bitterness. Lettuce likes steady (but not excessive) moisture and can become prematurely bitter during dry spells; keep irrigated for best-tasting leaves.



Lettuce No30

Grand Rapids lettuce. light green, quality, sweet crisp, no fiber, not easy bolting, fast growth, maturity, insect resistance is strong, a wide adaptability,



Lettuce No31

Adaptive variety easy for growing in all cycles. Suitable in open field and greenhouse. Crispy red leaf with strongly corrugated.



Lettuce Red NO32

Lollo Rossa The plant of this variety is large, with loose leaves and wrinkled leaves. It likes cold and cool environment. The suitable temperature for growth is 15-25 °C, Beautiful, crisp and fragrant, good quality, no bitterness, is a new product for export and restaurants



Lettuce No33

Oak type , Leaf variety for both protected and open field. oak leaf shaped leaves that are medium green with red and green veining under-side. The red surface blush turns a deep burgundy as they mature. Full sun brings out the deep-red color. This variety has some heat resistance. Good regrowth for multiple cuttings. Cool season annual
Maturity: Approx. 28-50 days
Planting season: Spring or fall
